4. Member States should perform technological assessments of their national innovation systems at regular intervals drawing from regional and international foresight exercises.

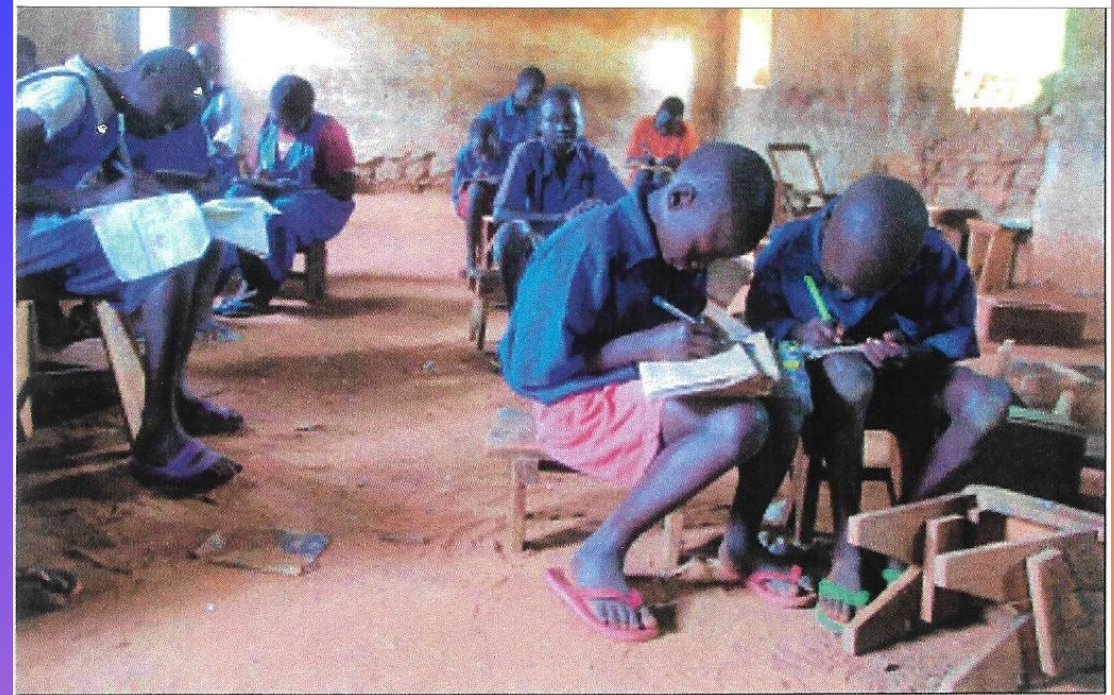

There is a rich diversity of ways on knowing, which realizes on a broad and open process.

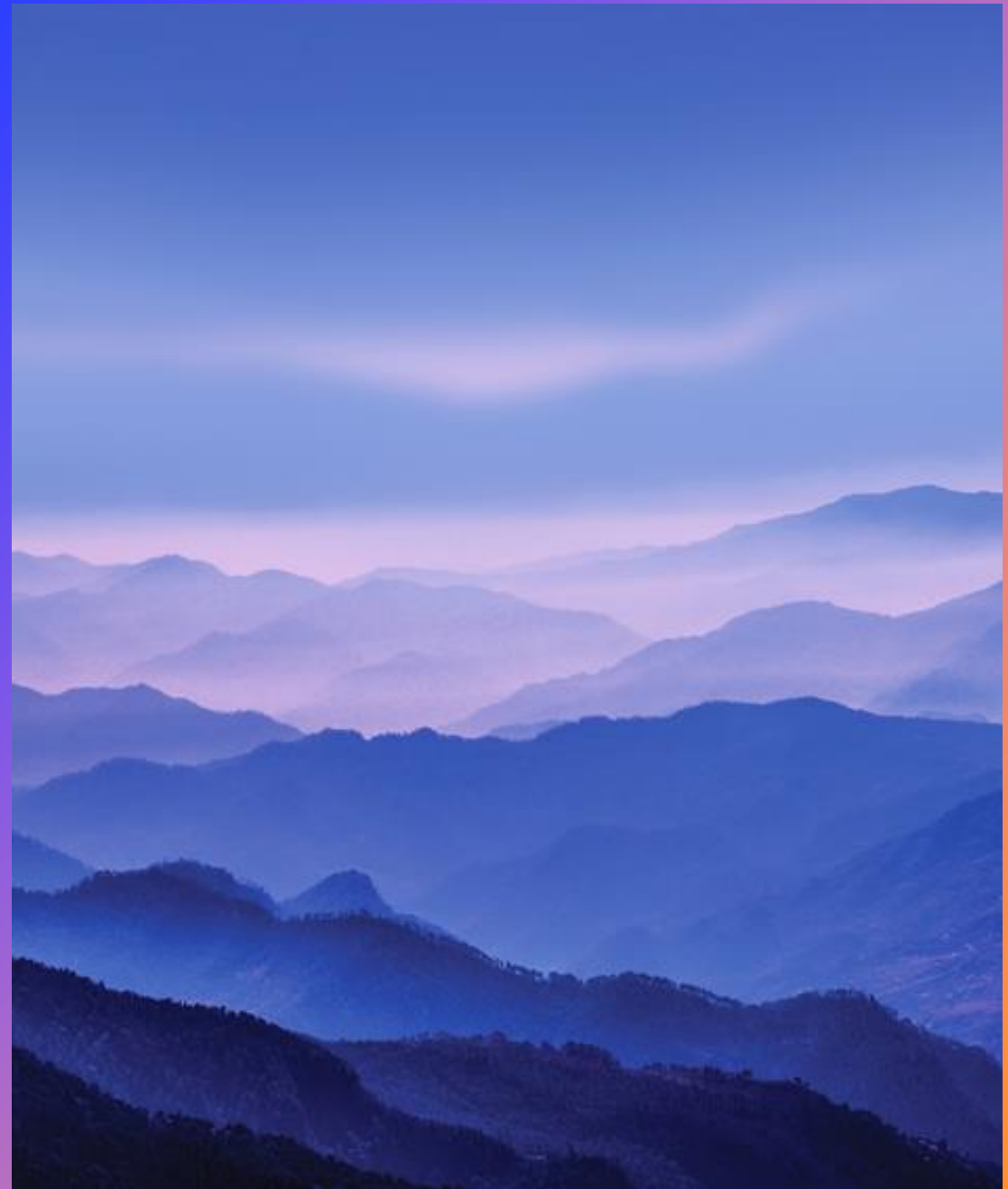
