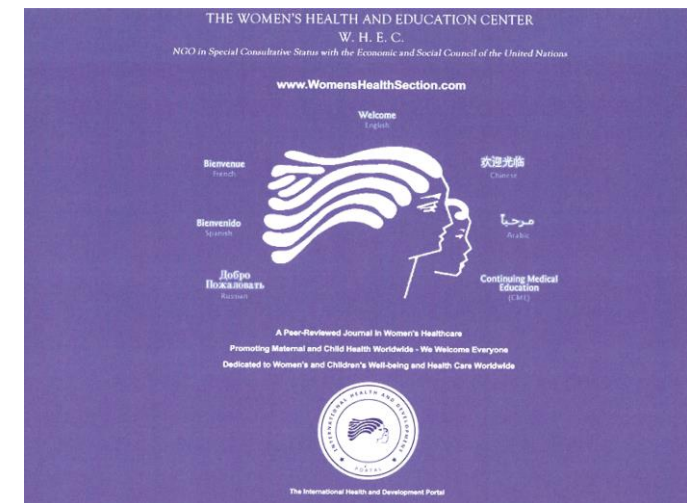
Sustainable Development Goals Framework
